

# JACKET ENLARGE

making a nice looking jacket some sizes larger - re-sizing and defying the terror of fashion mathematics.

a *>SELF\_PASSAGE<* method

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1. take that old jacket just a little too small these days (maybe shrank in the wash?).



2. cut the front parts in two. try to follow some contour of the cut/pattern.



3. cut back too - make cuts meet at the top shoulder.



4. could look something like this.



5. attach a 3 cm wide cotton ribbon all along the cut. let the fabric overlap about 5mm, also the inner lining from underneath.



6. attach with a wide zig-zag seam. repeat on both sides. the fit of the inner lining is not that important.



7. a small jacket now larger.



8. growing confidence by re-form.
